What's covered?

The City & Guilds Award has ten units and is designed to give learners the basic knowledge, to enable them to progress towards the minimum qualifications or skill levels needed for entry into the industry.

The units are:

- Engine lubrication
- Engine cooling
- Fuel & exhaust systems
- Spark ignition systems
- Electrical systems
- Braking systems
- Transmission systems
- Steering systems
- Wheel & tyre systems
- Body & interior cleaning

What do you need?

You don't need to have studied motor vehicle before this course. You need a lively and enquiring mind, an interest in vehicles, a willingness to explore new ideas and the ability to communicate your ideas effectively.

How are you assessed?

This course places an emphasis on learning by doing and to gain the full certificate, learners need to complete practical tasks for each unit, and oral questions for the units on engine lubrication, spark ignition systems, steering and wheel and tyre systems.

What next?

This course is suitable for those wishing to progress onto an NVQ or Modern Apprenticeship. Alternatively this course helps pupils progress into a career in the motor industry, a motor mechanic, motor sports, body work repair or further education.
